Middle-Tier Architecture

Innovative middle-tier object for fast, scalable and maintainable code

Tag-Based Database API

Tag-based database API for storing denormalized data (like MongoDB) means no need to modify database tables for changing web content on the front end

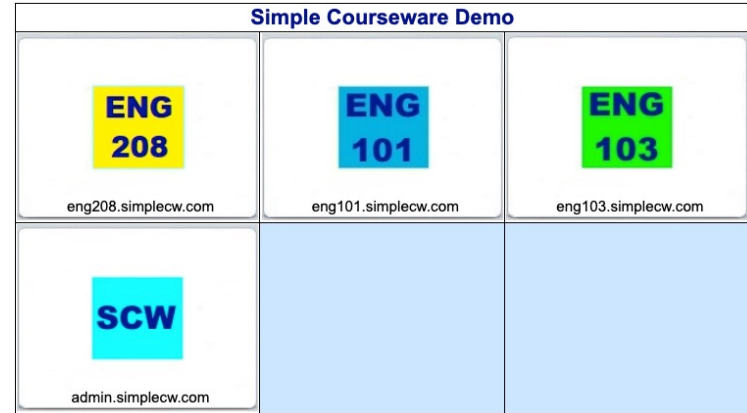
